On Tuesday, March 10, our 3<sup>rd</sup> year students take the state-funded ACT (no cost to families) during the school day at Defiance. This includes juniors who attend Four County Career Center. The ACT assesses what students learn in high school and gives personalized information about strengths for educational and career planning.

Except for students with testing accommodations, ACT testing will occur in our high school gymnasium.

- Students who attend Defiance report to their 1<sup>st</sup> period class for attendance. We plan to have an announcement to dismiss students to their testing location.
- Four County students report directly to the high school office by 7:45 AM.
- Any drivers should park in the football lot near Defiance High School.

Testing should conclude around 12:30 PM.

- After that, students with classes at Defiance finish the day with lunch and their regular schedule.
- Four County students may leave after testing if they have transportation. They do not report to Four County at all that day.

Please remember the following items on test day:

- Sharpened, soft lead No. 2 pencils and good erasers (no mechanical pencils or ink pens)
- A **permitted** calculator <[www.act.org/calculator-policy.html](http://www.act.org/calculator-policy.html)>
- No other devices (cell phone, smart watch, fitness band) or reading materials
