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DES Information

Winter Weather

Please keep in mind that winter weather has arrived. Shorts are not appropriate to wear during these cold months. Most of our children go outside for recess at least twice a day and need to be properly clothed. A coat is necessary every day. In the event of snow, all-weather boots are required to play in the wet snow. Children without snow boots will remain on the blacktop areas. Please note, if the wind chill is above 20°F, we have outside recess. Thank you for your cooperation.

Title I Information

As a parent, you have the right to know about the teaching qualifications of your child's classroom teacher in a school receiving Title I funds. Federal regulations require that any local school district receiving Title I funds must notify parents that they may ask about the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher.

These qualifications include:

- 1. Whether the teacher has met the Ohio teacher licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides your child instruction.
- 2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status that waives state licensing requirements.
- 3. The undergraduate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate degree or certification (such as National Board Certification) held by the teacher and the field of discipline of certification or degree.
- 4. Whether your child is provided services by instructional paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.
