

Student Vacations: At DES, our commitment to providing the best education possible is based upon your students' attendance at school. While we understand that there are unavoidable circumstances where students must miss school, we ask that you limit these absences and try to schedule time off during our scheduled breaks.

Solar Eclipse: Our district, following the advice of the Solar Eclipse Task Force of Defiance County, will not be in session on Monday, April 8. Teachers will report for a work day; however, students will not be in attendance.

Teacher Requests: It's hard to believe that we are planning for next school year already, but we are! We have a "no request" policy for teachers. This has worked well for our district and our classrooms are very well distributed based on boy/girl ratio, as well as behavior and academic needs of our children. We will follow this same policy for the 2024-2025 school year. If you have a teacher that you would like to exempt your child from having, please see the office secretary for a form or print one from our school website. However, requests will not be accepted.

K - 2 Information

Kindergarten Registration: If you have a child that will be five years of age on or before September 30, please call the K-2 office during the month of March to register for Kindergarten. Defiance City Schools offers two kindergarten aged programs, KinderStart (early five program) and regular kindergarten. Students must meet the age requirement for both programs.

Our registration will run throughout the month of March with the actual screening taking place April 9-11. Parents with students *currently* enrolled in our KinderStart program will NOT need to register or go through the screening process again. Our KS students will automatically be placed in a regular Kindergarten classroom next school year.

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Ohio State Spring Assessments: As you know, the way that student achievement is being measured throughout the state of Ohio has changed.
