

For Tax Exempt Computer Purchases.

Computers purchased for home use are tax deductible as per Sales Tax Law H.B. 215:

“Sales of computers, computer monitors, computer keyboards, modems, and other peripheral equipment to an individual who is licensed or certified to teach in an elementary or a secondary school in this state for use by that individual in preparation for teaching elementary or secondary school in this state for use by that individual in preparation for teaching elementary or secondary school students.”

#1 and #2 documents can be obtained from the Tech Coordinator

Each computer product has different procedures, here are the instructions from an Apple machine. Typically, you'll pay the tax up front, then Apple will reimburse the cost.

3 items need to be faxed to Apple:

1) Place your teaching certificate on the DCS letterhead, make a copy. (to make a faxable copy)

2) Fill out your information on the tax exempt form (the top is already completed for you)

3) A fax cover sheet that includes:

Your name

Address

Email address if available

Your order number from your computer purchase
